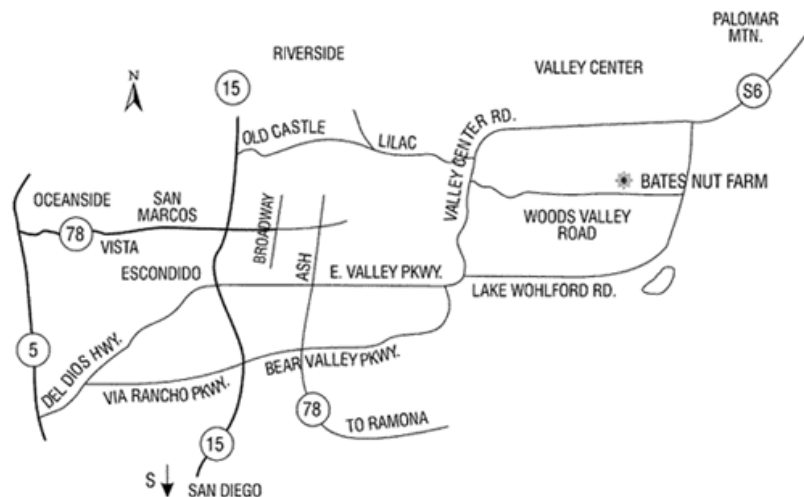

\* Effective as of 1/1/2009 - See Chapter 3, Section 7 of AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows: "The Amateur Owner-Handler Class shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, an AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13)."

\*\* Bred By Exhibitor Class Eligibility:

1. All dogs entered in the Bred by Exhibitor class must be individually registered with the AKC.
2. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.
3. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in this class.

## BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Grand Champion Select points offered at judge's discretion.

There will be **NO Obedience or Junior Showmanship Classes offered at this Specialty.**

## SWEEPSTAKES

Sweepstakes will be judged before the regular classes and is open to all breeders and owners of Bulldogs. The classes will be divided by age and by sex, and all classes exclude Champions. Any dog entered in Sweepstakes must be entered in the Regular classes.

PROFESSIONAL HANDLERS MAY SHOW THEIR OWN DOGS ONLY

SWEEPSTAKES CLASSES - The following classes are divided by sex:

Puppy 6 months/under 9 months

Puppy 9 months/under 12 months

Dogs and Bitches 12 months/under 18 months

Entry fee in Sweepstakes for each Bulldog entered is \$20.00 and is in addition to the regular entry fee. All entries must be made at the same time regular entries are made and on the same entry blank with "SWEEPSTAKES" noted in the additional box.

## SWEEPSTAKES PRIZES

**CASH PRIZES:** After 35% has been deducted for expenses, all entry fees in each class division will be rounded to the nearest dollar and divided as follows:

## SET-UPS:

- Personal tents and personal generators will be allowed in designated areas only, no exceptions.
- No exercise pens or set-ups within 20 feet of the rings or in the Fire Lanes.
- No exercise pens or set-ups in Main Day of Show Parking lot.
- Dogs on grooming loops must be attended at all times.
- No Vehicles or Vehicle Traffic will be allowed on the show grounds for loading or unloading. Unloading is open from 6:15 am till 7:30 am.

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Conditional, unassigned, incomplete, telephoned or telegraphed entries cannot be accepted. Entries without fees cannot be accepted.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC FORMS or photocopies of entry forms without the agreement and rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry forms are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to the close of entries. Changes which are received on the telephone are unacceptable.

OWNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR ERRORS. On entry blanks, and for entering the same dog twice, or for entering a dog in a class in which it is ineligible to compete, regardless of who makes such errors.

CONFIRMATION OF ENTRY & SCHEDULE OF JUDGING TIME will be sent to the address on the Official AKC Entry Form after the closing date. If an exhibitor has not received a copy of the Schedule of Judging seven days prior to the show, the Show Secretary should be contacted.

Dogs may be moved FROM ONE DIVISION OF THE PUPPY CLASS TO ANOTHER or a CORRECTION TO THE SEX OF A DOG may be made, or a dog, which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a championship after the closing of entries of the show but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to Best of Breed or Variety competition, provided this transfer is made by the Show Secretary one half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show. (AKC Rules, Chapter 11, Sec 8)

DOGS NEED TO BE AT THE SHOW only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after, unless required for further judging.

DOGS MUST BE READY FOR JUDGING. The club and/or its Show Secretary will not be responsible for, and are not obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class judging. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or their agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.
