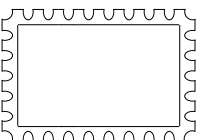

# Classifications

The following classes will be provided for both dogs and bitches and applies to all three Shows:

## REGULAR CLASSES

Puppy, 6 months and under 9 months	Bred by Exhibitor
Puppy, 9 months and under 12 months	American Bred
Junior, 12 months and under 18 months	Open
Amateur Owner Handle	Winners
Best of Breed	

Please be advised of the following about Bred-by-Exhibitor (BBE) Class Eligibility:

ALL dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC.

The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog.

To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

## VETERAN CLASSES

(Involving Single Dog Entries, to be judged after Winners but before Best of Breed.)

**DOGS & BITCHES:** Open to any dog/bitch seven (7) years of age or older, on or prior to the day of the show.

## NON-REGULAR CLASSES

(Involving Multiple Dog Entries, to be judged after Best of Breed.)

**STUD DOG:** For Stud Dogs and at least two, but not more than four of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not be the owner of the Get. The Stud Dog will be the regular entry, this being the regular entry fee, plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. Get only to be judged, based on the merits of the Get. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with his Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its Breed. Each Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class of the same show. The entry form of each Get must state this competition and requires no additional fee.

**BROOD BITCH:** Same as above except substitute "Brood Bitch" for "Stud Dog", "Produce" for "Get" and "her" for "his".

As the Judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these Classes.

## Motor Home /RV Parking Agreement

MOTOR HOME/RV PARKING RESERVED SPACES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE FAIR-  
GROUNDS FROM NOON MARCH 16, 2012, UNTIL 3 HOURS AFTER BEST OF BREED  
COMPETITION ON MARCH 18, 2012.

Motor Home/RV Reservations are available for a Pre-Paid Fee of \$18.00 per night. Parking without a Pre-paid reservation is available for \$23.00 per night. Only Motor Homes/RVs will be permitted in the Reserved RV Parking area. A typical space is 40' x 18'. All units must be self-contained. A limited number of electrical hookups are available on a first-come-first serve basis; however, the show graving clubs do not guarantee the functioning of the Fairground's circuit breakers available. No waste or gray water is to be discharged onto the grounds. Potable water is available on-site and Restroom facilities are available 24 hours during the show period. Anyone arriving without their Motor Home/RV will forfeit their space, and no refund will be made. It is noted that a CSX rail line is adjacent to the Fairgrounds and is an active line. RV owners will be responsible for maintaining the cleanliness of their space. RV overnight reservations are a privilege extended by the Charles Country Fair, Inc. Any arguing, abusive language or failure to follow the rules or the directions of show officials by the RV applicant and accompanying members may result in the removal of said persons and their RV from the Fairgrounds, and forfeiture of all parking privileges without refund of fees paid and the possibility of discipline by the Event Committee and or the AKC. Parking is strictly at the Applicant's risk. The Bulldog Club of America, Division VII, The Capitol Bulldog Club, Inc. and the Charles Country Fair, Inc. are by virtue of the submittal of the Reservation Application indemnified by the applicant for responsibility for loss by fire, theft or damage or loss of personal property, or the loss or injury to animals in their charge while on the show grounds. Applicant must vacate the fairgrounds no later than date/time stated above. Parking in the RV Restricted Area is on a First-Come-First Served basis and no spaces will be pre-reserved. - ENTRY FEE WILL NOT BE REFUNDED** in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of Event Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

Violators will be subject to action by the Event Committee and if found in violation, suspension of AKC privileges may be recommended.

- Sunday, March 18, 2011, at 7:00 AM until one (1) hour after Best of Breed (all three days). **DOGS ARE NOT ALLOWED OVERNIGHT IN SHOW ROOM & GROOMING AREA.**
- SHOW HOURS:** Consult Judging Program for time of judging. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. See show site availability above. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it at ring-side when its classes are called to be judged. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.
  - CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be made in the ring before the judging of the breed is over and the Show Secretary is advised at once. The Secretary, Administrator, and Show-giving clubs disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.
  - ALL TROPHIES MUST BE CLAIMED** the day of the show. Any unclaimed trophies will revert to the general trophy fund after the showing of the breed
  - ALL DOGS PRESENT MUST BE HELD ON A LEASH OR CONFINED TO THEIR CRATES** except when being judged
  - LOADING ZONE** will be designated near the grooming entrance to show building. Please park in the general parking area once unloading is done.
  - GROOMING AREA:** The Show Building will have designated grooming areas restricted to Exhibitors/ Handlers and under control of the Event Committee. No mats or rugs on the floor are allowed. A limited number of electrical outlets area available. Crate tags are encouraged. Stacking may be enforced as necessary.
  - GROOMING AREA MUST** be cleared each day one (1) hour after Best of Breed competition. Any items left behind in grooming area after closing will be at the risk of the owner.
  - GROOMING** dogs in areas other than as designated is not permitted. This will be strictly enforced.
  - NO CRATING OR GROOMING** will be allowed near conformation ring.
  - A PRE-RING WAITING AREA** will be established near the ring entrance. Only dogs and handlers in the next immediate class are allowed in this area.
  - FOOD/DRINK:** Not provided except during hospitality. There are numerous eating places within a reasonable distance of the fairgrounds. NO ALCOHOLIC beverages are allowed in the show building.
  - RESTROOMS** are located in Building A.
  - NO DOGS OR FEED BOWLS ALLOWED** in restrooms. Persons found violating this rule are subject to action by the Event Committee.
  - NO SMOKING** is allowed in any of the Fairgrounds buildings. Smokers, please use the ash cans located outside the show building to extinguish your cigarettes.
  - TRASH RECEPTACLES** and potable water will be available in the show area.
  - HANDICAPPED FACILITIES** are available.
  - PLEASE OBEY** all posted signs. Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities. ALL EXHIBITORS MUST HELP to maintain this site by assisting in keeping it in excellent condition.
  - ALL EXHIBITORS ARE CHARGED** with the responsibility of cleaning in and around their vehicles, crates, and dogs. Please clean up after your dog(s) immediately. Please dispose of all garbage in proper containers.
  - RV PARKING** available. See page 13 for information.
